Cardstock Circle Templates	1		Print our PDF template onto Cardstock to make spinning wheels. Templates come in multiples on 1 PDF sheet.
Bamboo Skewers	1		We like the 3 to 3.5mm diameter skewers to make axles. Have students measure and cut into 2" lengths. You can also pre-cut skewers for younger students or Maker events.
Paper Straws	1		Use to make bearings for your wheels and axles. Measure and cut into 1" lengths. You can also pre-cut straws for younger students or Maker events.
Large Pony Beads	4-10		Use to secure your skewer axles. Make sure they fit onto the skewers you are using. Beads are also great for custom decorations.
Popsicle Sticks	Various		This is a great project to use your spare and scrap popsicle parts! You can use regular and jumbo sticks. Cut into 1-1.5" lengths. We like to collect scraps throughout the year to use for this project.
Re-Purposed & Spare Parts	Various		We also like to save and re-purpose other scraps and spare parts. Anything small will work - small beads, caps, buttons, straws, etc.
Other Craft Items	Various		You can also add other small decorative items like pom poms, googly eyes, sequins, etc.

Hot Glue	We recommend setting up a hot glue station with multiple glue guns.
Hole Punches	Use standard hole punches.
Tools To Cut Wood	We recommend Pruning Shears, Diagonal Cutters or Large Wire Cutters. You can pre-cut skewers and popsicle sticks into the desired lengths for younger makers or shorter community Maker events.
